**** RULES & GUIDELINES ****

1. Fresh flower exhibits will be entered on Wednesday, August 8th from 7:00 AM to 11:00 AM ONLY in the new Grafton Building Exhibit Hall. No entries will be taken after this time as judging will begin.
2. Judging will be Wednesday and their decision is final. Each entry will be marked with an entry tag for identification purposes. ALL ENTRIES must remain anonymous until judging is complete. No one is allowed in during the judging.
3. A person may enter one exhibit in each class number whether it be individual or a grouping of plants. If there isn't a classification, the display can be entered in the "other" category.
4. Separate awards shall be given in all classes and for display on an individual basis. PROFESSIONALS AND AMATEURS WILL NOT BE JUDGED TOGETHER. Amateurs will be on one side of the Horticulture display and the professionals on the other side.
