Show Dates & Times:

Rabbit Show: Wednesday, April 20th 6:30 pm

Chicken Show: Wednesday, April 20th 8:00 pm

Goat Show: Thursday, April 21st 7:00 pm

Check in: All animals need to be checked in to the indoor arena (see map below) between 8 am and 5pm on April 20th.

Check out: All animals must be picked up between 8:00 pm and 10:00 pm on Saturday April 23rd -or- between 8:00 am and 10:00 am on Sunday April 24th.

RULES & GUIDELINES

1. This show is open to any Washington County Citizen, kindergarten through 12th grade.
2. All animals must have been owned for at least 60 days prior to the Fair Show.
3. Exhibitors may enter only 1 exhibit per class. However, exhibitors may enter more than one class.
4. Animals and exhibitors must check in for the show 1 hour prior to their specific show time.
5. All exhibitors must be ready to present their animal(s) and answer questions from the judge.
6. Pens – due to the limited amount of space and number of pens, pens will be issued upon registration and no participants will be accepted once pens are filled.

7. Exhibit animals will be left for the duration of the county fair and will be looked after by the fair board and volunteers. Chicken feed, alfalfa pellets, alfalfa hay, and water will be provided for your animal during the fair. If your animal requires a specific feed, enough feed for 4 days will need to be left with your animal.
8. The Washington County Fair Livestock Board reserves the right to dismiss any animals that appear to be unhealthy or pose any undue harm or risk to exhibitors, livestock, or patrons of the show, as well as animals that do not conform to the rules of the show.
9. If your animal is for sale, you may post a for sale card on the animal's pen indicated the animal is for sale and only your contact information.

CLASS/CATEGORIES:

CLASS 1 CHICKENS – PULLETS

May enter one (1) exhibit per person. An exhibit is comprised of your best 1 to 3 pullets. A pullet is a chicken that has not started laying yet, typically under 6 months of age, and all birds should be the same breed. Birds will be judged on confirmation and market quality.

CLASS 2 CHICKENS – LAYER

May enter one (1) exhibit per person. An exhibit is comprised of your best laying bird. Typically, these are chickens over 6 months old. Birds will be judged on confirmation and market quality.

CLASS 3 CHICKENS – SHOW BIRDS – BEAUTY CONTEST

May enter one (1) exhibit per person. An exhibit is comprised of a single bird, male or female. Birds will be judged on plumage, overall attractiveness, confirmation, and health. This class is often called a "fancy show" and focuses on unique breeds that are characterized by their feathers, breed type, and not their ability to lay eggs. This class may also include roosters.

CLASS 4 GOATS – MEAT

May enter one (1) exhibit per person. An exhibit is comprised of a single male or female goat over the age of 8 months (no Billy's allowed). Any meat breed or multi-function breed can be shown. Goats will be judged on confirmation and market quality.

CLASS 5 GOATS – PET

May enter one (1) exhibit per person. An exhibit is comprised of a single male or female goat of any age (no Billy's allowed). Any breed can be shown. Goats will be judged according to style, personality, and grooming.

CLASS 6 RABBIT – SHOW ANIMALS, PET

May enter one (1) exhibit per person. An exhibit is comprised of a single male or female rabbit over the age of 4 months old. Rabbits will be judged on confirmation, grooming and breed characteristics.

CLASS 7 ALL ANIMAL - COSTUME SHOW

May enter one (1) exhibit per person. An exhibit is comprised of a single male or female chicken, rabbit, or goat (no Billy's). Both the exhibitor and animal may be dressed up, or only the animal. Participants will be judged on creativity, and how materials are used in creating the costume.

Registration will be open from February 1st through April 8th or until all available animal pens are full.
