### **ENTRY TIMES:**

Wednesday, April 20<sup>th</sup> from 8:00AM to 11:00 AM in the Harmony Legacy Building

### **GENERAL RULES & GUIDELINES:**

1. Fresh flower exhibits will be entered on Wednesday, April 14 from 7:00AM to 11:00AM ONLY in the Harmony Legacy Building. No entries will be taken after this time as judging will begin.
2. Judging will be Wednesday, April 20 and their decision is final. Each entry will be marked with an entry tag for identification purposes. ALL ENTRIES must remain anonymous until judging is complete. No one is allowed in during the judging.
3. A person may enter one exhibit to each class number whether it be individual or a grouping of plants. If there isn't a classification, the display can be entered in the "other" category.
4. Separate awards shall be given in all classes and for display on an individual basis. PROFESSIONALS AND AMATEURS WILL NOT BE JUDGED TOGETHER. Amateurs will be on one side of the horticulture display and the professionals on the other side.
5. All arrangements must be picked up no later than Monday, April 25<sup>th</sup> between 9am and 5pm to avoid disrupting the spirit of the fair.
6. Entries made in this department are limited to legal residents of the county.
7. Premiums may be redeemed the premium bank during the designated hours. Premiums not redeemed by Monday, April 25, at 5:00 pm may be redeemed at the Washington County Treasurer's Office at 197 East Tabernacle, St. George. All premiums must be redeemed by May 30, 2022 or the premium will be forfeited.
